

Tips for A Successful Visa Interview

Request your letter of invitation and make your appointment for a visa interview early. Wait times for a visa interview can be several weeks or more in many countries, especially during peak travel periods. With this in mind, you are strongly urged to place your request for a letter of invitation to attend NRF 202 Retail's Big Show Chapter Two as soon as possible.

Here are some tips to make your visa interview successful:

- Request a letter of invitation from NRF 2021 Retail's Big Show Chapter Two. The sooner you request your letter of invitation, the better, as it may take longer to apply for a visitor visa.
- Make your appointment with your embassy as soon as you receive your invite visa letter and make sure you have your letter available for your interview.
- Verify fees and requirements.
- Show proof of "strong ties" that bind you to your country of residence. The consular officers conducting interviews look for proof that you will return to your country. Evidence of "strong ties" includes proof of business ownership or employment, social and family relationships.
- If you have traveled to the U.S. previously, provide documentation demonstrating that you returned to your country on time. Use an airline ticket stub or boarding pass to show your return flight or meeting materials that show you attended a business conference as proof that you returned within the timeframe you stated.
- With your application, include any materials NRF 2021 Retail's Big Show Chapter Two may have sent you. Include with your application any printed conference materials you received from NRF 2021 Retail's Big Show Chapter Two to prove that the conference and exhibition is a legitimate business event.
- Present your entire trip itinerary with your application. Include any plans you may have.
